Location – the magnificent Sir Don Rowlands centre at Gate 2 of the Karapiro Domain.

- If you're approaching from the North, just follow the new Cambridge bypass section
 of the Waikato expressway all the way to the end where it links into the familiar road
 to Tauranga. Keep going about 1km until you see the turn off to Karapiro village –
 first road on right. Follow that down to the river and cross the dam. Make a left turn
 and follow the signs to Gate 2.
- If you're coming from the South on the road from Te Awamutu look for a right turn at Lamb St by the big power pylons as you approach Cambridge. It is signposted to the Lake. Go straight across the top end of Leamington and you'll get there eventually
- If you're coming from the East you have the choice of crossing the river at the Horahora bridge or carrying on down SH1 to Karapiro
- Anyone coming from the West should know where it is anyway but head up Shakespeare St in Learnington and turn left at Browning St or Lamb St at the top end
- If you get lost please call event manager Bill on 027 287 0596. We'll text those of you who supplied a cell phone number in the unlikely case of the dam being closed.

Please note – play starts at 9:30am

Morning munchies will be available from 9:00 and there'll be a coffee cart out front. We aim to finish by 5:20pm in time for you to explore Cambridge's many fine choices of eatery before heading home.

Things you may like to bring:


- Fantastic themed costumes for your team
