JUNIOR TOURNAMENT BIDDING - STRONG
 MULTI 2D
WEAK 2 s in the Majors
STRONG MULTI 2D
Opening 2D has 2 meanings (and nothing necessarily to do with Ds - ALERT!!!)

1. 19-20 points and a flat hand
2. 19-22 points and a long minor (6 cards plus).

How does the bidding proceed in each case?
The responder bids 2 H (ALERT - nothing necessarily to do with Hs) It is a RELAY bid saying to partner - okay, describe your hand to me some more please?

Opener then rebids their hand:
Either: 2NT - balanced 19/20
Or: Bids their minor - at least 6 in length - 19-22 pts unbalanced
If partner rebids 2NT:
Use Puppet Stayman style answers (no jumps for point count) Bidding sequence eg. 1

Partner:
2D Strong Multi 2D
2NT (19/20 flat)
3D (4 card major held)
3NT (I was holding Hs)

You:
2H (Relay)
3C (Puppet Stayman)
3H (I hold 4Ss and may hold 4Hs)
4H (I had Hs as well ... )

If partner rebids 2NT:
Use Transfers to MAJORS ONLY(including Hs)
Bidding sequence eg. 2

Partner:
2D (Multi 2D strong)
2NT (19/20 flat)
3S

You:
2H (relay)
3H (transfer to Ss)
3NT(choose if we play in NT or Ss)
Bidding Sequence eg. 3 2D 2NT 3H

2H (relay)
3D (transfer to Hs)
3NT (choose if we play in NT or Hs)

Responder will be declarer in eg 3
Best to describe your hand
Use 3 S bid to show 5 SPADES and 4 HEARTS EXACTLY

Weak 2 opening bids 2 H or 2 S

- I hold 6 cards in the suit
- I have 6 to 10 points
- This suit will look no worse than Q 10 at the top.

How do you respond?
LTT - bid to your trump number. (shade if VUL)
If you hold 4 of the weak 2 suit - bid game straight away to cut out ops.

Particularly if you are weak and it seems likely game is on for ops
Particularly if the suit is spades.

If you hold 14+ points - use OGUST
Bid 2NT - ALERT - asked opener to describe the Weak 2 suit in more detail
Replies are:
3C - 6 to 8 points - 1 top honour
3D - 6 to 8 points -2 top honours
$3 \mathrm{H}-9$ to 10 points -1 top honour
3S - 9 to 10 points - 2 top honours
3NT - all three top honours
What is a top honour?
AKQ
How do I remember OGUST replies?
Pretend to be a band leader ...
It's simply, a 1, a 2, a 1, 2, 3

## The opening 2NT bid: 21-22 HCP

Use Puppet Stayman style answers (no jumps for points) Bidding sequence eg. 1

| 2NT | 3C (Puppet Stayman) |
| :--- | :--- |
| 3H (5 card Hs) | 3NT |

Use transfers to MAJORS only.
Bidding sequence eg. 2
2NT
3D (transfer)
3H
3NT (choose contract)
Use 3S bid to show 5 SPADES and 4 HEARTS EXACTLY

## Semi-Pre-empting with a 7 card Minor

$3 C$ or $3 \mathrm{D}=6-10$ pts and a 7 card minor promising 2 of the top 3 honours.
Majors remain just 7 cards
Why is this a semi-pre-empt with a minor?

- Your p can use LTT and pre-empt higher if weak
- It is looking for 3NT with the right hand opposite.
- It makes life more difficult for ops
- Pre-empt as strong and as hard as you can - especially if non-vul against vul


## BERGEN RAISES

Showing an agreed 9-card fit and point count early in the auction.
Partner opens 1 of a major, either 1 H or 1 S
The Bergen responses are based on LTT and are:
Opener bids 1H...
Responder bids:
$3 \mathrm{H}=$ weak 0-6 pts and 4 Hs
$3 \mathrm{C}=7$-a poor 10 pts and 4 Hs
$3 \mathrm{D}=\operatorname{good} 10-12$ and 4 Hs
$2 N T=13+$ pts and 4 Hs
Opener's rebids:
Add up your points and distribution
$1 \mathrm{H}-3 \mathrm{H}-$ ?
Unless you have a huge hand, PASS
1H-3C-?
Rebid of 3 H - responder should forget game, even if you have 10 pts it is not enough. Trust your partner!

Rebid of 3D - I'm not sure about game if you have 9/10 bid game, if you have 7/8 bid 3H

Rebid of 4 H - sign off - Game on, Slam off
1S-3C - ?
Rebids:
$3 S=$ minimum opener, sign off
$3 \mathrm{D}=$ invitational - go to game with $9-10$. Bid 3 S if $7 / 8$.
1S-3D - ?
$3 \mathrm{H}=$ invitational - go to game with 11-12, sign off in 3 S if just 10

1H - 2NT - ?
$3 \mathrm{H}=\mathrm{I}$ have $17+\mathrm{pts}$
3NT = I have 15-16 pts
$4 \mathrm{H}=\mathrm{I}$ was minimum opener. 12-14 pts. Unless you have heaps more, leave it in game.

4 of a new suit $=5$ card suit with $6 / 5$ shape .

## Australian Bergen

Showing points in an 8 card fit
P openers $1 \mathrm{H} / 1 \mathrm{~S}$ and you hold points and only $3 \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{S}$ - how do you show this?
$1 \mathrm{H}-2 \mathrm{H}=6-9$ pts and 3 card support
$1 \mathrm{H}-2 \mathrm{~S}=10-12$ pts and 3 card support
$1 S-2 S=6-9$ pts and 3 card support
$1 \mathrm{~S}-3 \mathrm{H}=10-12$ pts and 3 card support
Have 13+ pts and 3 card support?
Bid another suit first, then show fit and strength by jumping to game.
Bidding sequence Eg. 1

1H
2D
$P$ now knows you have 3 card support.
