Opening Lead:

N opens a strong Multi2D despite holding a 5CM. S has 8HCP so offers the weakest response of 2H. Both bids must be alerted as unnatural. N now explains the hand by rebidding 2NT - flat with 19/20 HCP. S makes a Puppet Stayman enquiry. N answers 3S showing a 5CM. With 3 card support S bids the spade game.

Opening Lead:

S opens 2D and rebids to show a min. 6 card club suit. N has to decide what to do. There is an 8 card fit in Clubs but would NT be better? N must think about South's HCP. With 19 to 22 N holds the QC. Therefore at best only 8 of his partner's points are in Clubs. With at least 11 HCP elsewhere, 3NT should be possible.
