You can go via Puppet and RKCB but this gives opportunities for the ops to X to indicate lead preferences on artifical bids. You have the points go straight there.		North's intervention may seem a little light but he has good shape and is not vulnerable. East's X smacks strongly of his holding 4 spades. South "barrage bids" by jumping in hearts. This has merit because it soaks up bidding space for the side with points and because the LTT implies a profitable score with nine trumps. Holding good trumps, East's second X is for penalties. Although the contract goes 2 light for -300, it is a good sacrifice should E/W play in 4S.
